## The Children refugees - A journey of hope and survival

Each day, children from Tibet, Nepal, Bhutan and many other regions from the Himalayas are faced with unbearable and difficult living conditions and left out on the streets. Therefore, it is common for parents to part with their children by sending them into exile to India, with the hope that they will find the path to a better life and have access to basic education. Tragically, some of these children die while making the dangerous journey through the Himalayas to India. Those who are lucky enough to make it, travel by foot with nothing more than the clothes they are wearing. This humanitarian effort will save lives while giving hope to hundreds of children and young people.

The Project - How it will help these children refugees
The primary objective of the project is to inspire a worldwide effort in bringing together a network of sponsors, donors and volunteers to raise $\$ 1.8 \mathrm{M}$ US to fund the construction of a residential facility which will house more than 200 refugee and orphan children. Children refugees often suffer from handicaps or injuries throughout their exile journey. The funds raised for this project will ensure that these children receive the care they require.

Your donation will help to provide these orphan and refugee children with shelter and basic living amenities such as bedrooms, washrooms,
 kitchens and classrooms to care for and provide them with an education. The monastery provides the children with lodging, clothing,

## Integrity - Our Core Value

One hundred percent of the funds already raised have been invested in the project construction. The commitment to continue to directly invest the totality of the funds raised to the project construction is a core value for the project leaders. Thus far, all the labor and work performed on this project have been done by volunteers, ensuring that the entire amount of funds raised is used for building materials, equipment and appliances.


## The status of the construction

The construction started in early 2011 in Bylakuppe, Mysore District, India. 660'000\$ have been raised up to now, we still need to raise roughly 1M US by 2014. Due to the inflation in India, the price of building materials is currently doubling. This is the reason why this project is a priority to raise funds quickly in order to complete the construction on time, by 2014. The new facilities will include five levels with about 30 bedrooms per level, as of now 1 level has been completed. They will also include a main kitchen, two smaller kitchens, a library, study rooms, etc.
